Category	Photo Identification (Must be current)
	Irish/EU/UK driving licence or learner permit
	Passport (from country of citizenship)
	Irish certificate of naturalisation
	National Identity Card (EU/EEA/Swiss citizens)
	Proof of Address (Dated within six months of date on Vetting Invitation Form)
Credit Institutions	Bank Statement from a recognised bank (not private money lenders or Revolut)
	Building Society Statement
	Credit Union statement
	Credit Union passbooks
Utility Providers	Utility bill (the only utility bills accepted are: gas, electricity, television, broadband, waste & TV licence).
Government Bodies	Correspondence from government departments Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Revenue correspondence <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tax credit certificate - PAYE or tax refund letters - Tax documents from employment - Social Welfare correspondence <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jobseeker's Allowance or Benefit letter - Intreo appointment letter (for training or work schemes) - Public Services Card appointment notices - Child Benefit letter - Department of Education correspondence <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - SUSI grant approval or payment letter - Education Training Board (ETB) course info - College or student grant updates - Payslip from Government Department
Local Authorities	Letter from Local Council confirming tenancy

Two documents must be submitted, one to support identification (Photo ID) and one to support proof of address.

Applicants Under 18

Where an applicant under the age of 18 does not have the documentation outlined in the accepted documentation table above, the following will be accepted.

Identification
Birth Certificate
Written statement by a school principal or an accredited third level institution confirming attendance and address.
